Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages

The TESOL Program in the English Department of the Schools of Liberal Arts is partnering with Peking University to offer this semester-long teach-abroad internship in Beijing, China.



APPROXIMATE DATES

- February – June, or
- September – December

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- The teach-abroad internship is for at least one-semester and possibly two.
- This is a paid internship teaching English for academic purposes (EFL) at the Peking University Health Sciences Center
- Students will register for 3-credits of internship, ENG Z598 TESOL Internship.
- Students will teach EAP courses 10 hours per week, plus hold two office hours per week for the first semester

ELIGIBILITY

- Student must be in the MA (Master of the Arts) Program in English
- Student must have completed the TESOL Methods and TESOL Practicum courses.
- Students in the graduate TESOL Certificate Program will be considered if they have completed the TESOL Methods and TESOL Practicum courses, and have previous teaching experience.
- Student must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or better.

Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.

HOUSING

- Students are housed in apartments provided by Peking University as part of the appointment. (Housing is part of the teaching contract.)

- Tuition for 3 graduate credit hours: ~\$992 (2010 resident-rate) (
- Study Abroad Administrative Fee: \$75 (this fee will be automatically posted to your bursar account)
- TESOL Program (English) Administrative Fee: \$100 (this fee will be automatically posted to your bursar account)
- Health Insurance: \$26
- **Total: \$1193**

- RMB 3200/month (2010 rate)
- Free on-campus housing in faculty apartments
- Round-trip international airfare (ticket price is reimbursed)
- In-country (Chinese) health insurance
- Teaching Visa
