Rescue on the Euphrates

Results of Excavations at the Roman Frontier City of Zeugma



Zeugma caught the world's attention in 2000, when nearly half the site was flooded by a new dam on the Euphrates river in southeastern Turkey. The Packard Humanities Institute answered the call to save the city. This illustrated presentation recounts the rescue work of 2000, sharing the latest results with a focus on life in this river-front city from its rise under the successors of Alexander the Great to its fall at the hands of the Sasanians in A.D. 253.
