Application for a Minor in German

Have you considered a minor in German?

The minor in German is for students whose interest is in the German language as a tool of communication. Its emphasis is on competence in the skills of reading, writing, and understanding spoken German. The minor can be beneficial to students in the natural and social sciences, business, engineering and technology, other languages, and interdisciplinary subjects.

If you do the coursework to fulfill the requirements for a minor in German, and fill out an application for the minor, it will appear on your transcript. Hence it will enhance your employment opportunities. You may already have completed over 1/3rd of the coursework to fulfill the Liberal Arts second-year language proficiency requirement.

*What are the requirements?**

The Minor in German is a fifteen-credit-hour minor that requires completion of the courses listed below with a grade of C or above. A minimum of six credit hours have to be taken at IUPUI:

G203 Second-Year German I (3 cr. hrs.)*

G204 Second-Year German II (3 cr. hrs.)*

(*or equivalent, e.g. Special Credit at the 200-level).
