Proposed Revived Exit Survey

The Teaching & Advising Committee is proposing re-establishing the Teaching and Advising Exit Survey. The survey could be distributed to students in two ways:

--Via Canvas as a non-graded but required assignment in senior capstone courses; this could allow departments to add department-specific questions. To protect students' anonymity, a link to the survey could be provided to students via Canvas, as is currently done with the course evaluations.

-- As a special non-graded, non-credit senior "course" that would be created throughout the School of Liberal Arts and that would contain various documents that students already need to fill out.
